Programme	Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions (MSCA) - Innovative Training Networks (ITN)
Funding agency	European Commission
Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Training of early-stage researchers to provide enhanced career perspectives• Raise excellence and structure research and doctoral training• Foster international, interdisciplinary and intersectoral mobility
Themes	Free choice of topic (bottom-up)
Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Call for proposals: One call for proposal a year• Proposal submission: Several months after the call for proposals• Project start: About 8-12 months after proposal submission
Consortium	Usually 6-10 partners from academia and industry; additional associated partners
Duration	4 years
Funding rates	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 100% of personnel costs for up to 15 newly recruited researchers (max. 540 person-months)• Fixed allowances for consumables, travels, training, overhead and other costs, as well as for managing the network
Total funding	About 3-4 million euro per project
Success criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scientific and Technological Quality• Training• Implementation• Impact
Success rate	Estimated 10%
FP7 equivalent	FP7 People – Marie Curie Actions – Initial Training Networks
